Because we are using both arenas there will be ample time before classes to warm up in the arenas and there will be a small area set up between the trail course and arena #1 for warm up.

- Same horse and rider combination **cannot** cross enter W/T/J and canter/loping classes for placings or high point award.
- **\$40 "Schooling only" fee per horse—Perfect for trainers**, very flexible, unlimited rail classes all day, pattern classes if time allows after judge places class, may cross divisions, add & scratch at gate, no prizes/points, can't switch to compete at same show. *Must be considerate and follow direction or will be excused w/o refund.*
- Showing riders can school in rail classes, may school in pattern classes if time allows after judge places class. No placing or points given, **same class fees apply**, must put number upside down. May cross enter divisions when schooling.
- Trainers can ride for points/awards in all OPEN classes.

***This is a benefit show and ribbons are expensive, therefore they will not be handed out but some will be available for those who want them*
High point prizes for each division**

- Class order may change slightly throughout show as needed
- Classes with less than 5 riders may be canceled/combined
 - LEADLINE may be before or after lunch
 - Trail Classes may be ridden in any order
