

The Yucaipa Equestrian Arena Committee (YEAC) is committed to encouraging and supporting other equestrian clubs. Please review and share the following guidelines for using the Yucaipa Equestrian Center (YEC).

YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEANING UP ALL MANURE LEFT BY YOUR ANIMAL (horse, cow, dog, etc.). YOU CAN TAKE IT HOME WITH YOU OR DEPOSIT IT IN THE PROPER RECEPTICLES LOCATED ON THE FACILITY. THIS IS NOT ONLY A REQUEST BUT A CITY ORDINANCE SUBJECT TO FINE.

Entrance gates have been installed and will be locked and opened by the Park Rangers during designated park hours. (Roughly sunrise to sunset.)

No overnight parking/camping unless a special use permit has been obtained from the City of Yucaipa in advance.

No parking in undesignated areas such as next to the arena fencing or on the grass. All vehicles need to park in the front parking lot or the dirt lot in the back and be mindful not to block entrances and exits.

Park your rigs at your own risk. We are not responsible for theft or damage.

No driving across sidewalks, concrete, or dirt areas next to the arena.

No tying horses to the arena fencing.

The office should not be left unattended without an adult and the office door should remain locked when not in use.

The tables and chairs should not be removed from the YEAC office. If you need tables and chairs for an outside event, please use those from the smaller show office and put them away when finished.

Any YEAC equipment such as hoses, tools, etc. should be put back in its designated storage location after use.

CITY OF YUCAIPA PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All pets must be on a leash at all times.
2. Possession or consumption of any kind of alcoholic beverage is prohibited, except as a condition of a special event permit.
3. Fires in provided barbeques only. (There are no barbeques at YEC = no fires. Period)
4. No mutilation, defacing, or destruction of park property.
5. Games: No person shall play or engage in a game that may potentially endanger or harm other users of the park.
6. No littering – Please use trash cans.
7. No dumping outside garbage or trash.
8. No person shall conduct a business in a city park without first obtaining a city business license and a special event permit.
- 9. Violation subject to \$1000 fine.**
10. No motorized Vehicles.

11. A permit is required to place and use a bounce house on City Property. Permits can be obtained at the City of Yucaipa Community Center.
City of Yucaipa Ordinance #233
12. YOU ARE REQUIRED TO PROMPTLY COLLECT, PICK UP, AND REMOVE ALL FECAL MATTER LEFT BEHIND BY YOUR ANIMAL IN OR UPON THE PARK.
This section shall not, however apply to guide dogs for the blind or disabled persons. Dogs are prohibited at city sponsored events. Dogs providing or are being trained to provide services for disabled persons shall be exempt from this prohibition.

13. No horses allowed in the grass.
14. No smoking within the park.

15. No skateboarding, in-line skates, or similar wheeled devices.
City of Yucaipa Ordinance #191
16. Video Surveillance. This park employs video equipment for security purposes and may be monitored at any time.
17. For water conservation this property is irrigated with non-potable water. DO NOT DRINK.

YUCAIPA EQUESTRIAN ARENA RULES

You are using this public facility at your own risk.

- Turnout of horses is allowed, but horses must be supervised.
- If others are waiting to use arena, turnout is limited to 10 minutes.
- Loose horses must be removed when riders want to use the arena.
- When riders are in the arena, other horses may be lunged if controlled.
- No horses allowed on the grass, tied to trees, or loose outside arenas.
- Arenas are open to everyone unless reserved as an approved event.
- Arenas are closed to all non-participants during reserved events.
- Check www.YucaipaEquestrianCenter.com for calendar of reserved events.
- Arena is closed at 4pm the evening before events for watering and grooming.
- No one is allowed in arenas during watering or grooming. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- No motor vehicles allowed in arenas except by prior authorization.
