**High Point Program Rules**

- 1) There are 17 daily high point divisions. You must enter five classes in your division to be eligible for the daily high point.
- 2) One horse/rider combination is allowed per riding division. Riders may enter more than one division as long as they follow rules for that division regarding attire and equipment. English classes require English attire and saddle, Western classes require Western attire and saddle, and Ranch Horse classes require Ranch attire and Western saddle. See class descriptions and FAQ for more detail.
- 3) Riders cannot cross-enter walk/trot/jog divisions and loping/cantering divisions on the same horse.
- 4) There is no point keeping fee for daily awards.
- 5) Riders must show in the minimum number of classes each show to qualify for daily award.
- 6) Ties are broken by the greatest number of 1<sup>st</sup> places to decide the winner. If needed, 2<sup>nd</sup> places and on will be counted until a tie is broken. If this process does not break the tie, a coin toss will be used to break the tie.
- 7) If no participant qualifies for an award, no award is given for the division.
- 8) You are responsible for knowing and following the rules to qualify for awards. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.
- 9) Daily high point awards that are not picked up at the show will be held for one month. Pass Pioneers 4H Club will not ship the award. You must come to the show office to get your award, or make other arrangements to pick up your award.
- 10) All high point champions in the 17 divisions will receive a daily high point and reserve champion prize. The total points for both benefit horse shows will be awarded the high point buckle at the November Pass Pioneers 4H Club Benefit horse show. All award choices are made at the discretion of the Yucaipa Equestrian Arena Committee and the Pass Pioneers 4H Club. We do not guarantee specific award choices, quality or customization.
