The Yucaipa Equestrian Arena Committee (“YEAC”) invites you to be a sponsor for our Dottie Potter Memorial Fund. This was Dottie’s dream to help our community.

Dottie Potter was an extremely important and influential member of the Yucaipa community. She was the president of YEAC and a member of the Yucaipa City Planning Commission for several years, participated on the Wildwood Canyon State Park project, supported the Chamber of Commerce as a local business woman and was involved with many other community organizations. While she was involved in all areas of the community, her passion was for the equestrian community. Her greatest dream was to have a cover installed over the main arena to improve the facility for everyone. While she was with us, she worked tirelessly towards this goal. We now are working to make her dream a reality and honor her positive community influence.

YEAC is dedicated to supporting and maintaining the Yucaipa Equestrian Arena Facility for the benefit of horse lovers and people from this town and the surrounding communities. The equestrian facility is utilized for many different types of horse activities, and is especially important to our local young equestrians. There are multiple equestrian groups currently using the facility, including the Pass Pioneers 4-H Club which provides education and experience to local youth in the care and use of horses. This club has been especially successful, having multiple members qualify for and participate on the California State 4-H team at the Western National Roundup in Colorado every year since 2002. No other 4-H club in California has achieved that level of consistent excellence. The arena is also used by the local California State Horsemen’s Association chapter for gymkhana competitions, the Yucaipa open horse shows for youth and adult riders, and other group events. The San Bernardino Sheriffs’ Mounted Posse uses the facility for specialized mounted police training. YEAC provides arena cattle sorting events for all riders, and offers the opportunity to learn the basics of working cattle and gain experience to move on to higher level competitions.
